We also recognise that our operations create environmental impacts through travel, energy use, materials, chemicals, packaging and waste.

We are committed to preventing pollution, reducing our environmental impact and continually improving environmental performance across our business.

We will achieve this by:

- Complying with applicable environmental legislation, regulations, client requirements and other environmental obligations relevant to our activities.
- Preventing pollution by controlling the storage, transport, use and disposal of materials and by responding promptly to spills, leaks or other environmental incidents.
- Reducing waste wherever practicable through careful material use, reuse, recovery and recycling, and ensuring waste is segregated and disposed of through appropriate authorised routes.
- Minimising unnecessary consumption of energy, water, raw materials and packaging and considering whole-life environmental impact when making purchasing decisions.
- Planning technician travel, scheduling and logistics efficiently to reduce unnecessary vehicle mileage, idling, repeat journeys and associated emissions.
- Promoting repair, restoration and life-extension of existing surfaces wherever technically appropriate, helping clients reduce replacement waste, disruption and demand for new materials.
- Considering environmental performance when selecting products, suppliers and subcontractors and encouraging those working with us to support equivalent standards.
- Monitoring our carbon footprint and environmental performance, identifying practical opportunities to reduce emissions and resource use, and reviewing progress as part of normal business management.
- Providing employees and contractors with appropriate information, instruction and training so they understand their environmental responsibilities and follow relevant procedures.
- Communicating this policy to employees, customers, suppliers and other interested parties and making it available publicly where appropriate.

The effectiveness of this policy will be reviewed at least annually and following any significant change to our activities, legislation or environmental risks.
